ON CAJUN MAN'S SWAMP TOUR YOU CAN

BALD EAGLES (FROM OCT. - MAY)
MIGRATORY BIRDS (FROM SEPT. - FEB.)
ALLIGATORS (YEAR ROUND, "PEAK TIMES" ARE FROM MAY - NOV.)

You can also see whitetail deer, wild hogs, coyotes, rabbits, squirrels, opossum, armadillo, nutria, minks, otters, turtles and more throughout the area.

Bird species such as the bald eagle, the great blue heron and the lesser blue heron and the black crowned heron. The great white egret, snowy egrets, crane, cormorants, anhingas, roseate spoonbills, osprey, hawks, red headed woodpecker, owls, mallards, teal, coots, gallinules, etc.

Cypress trees with spanish moss, tupelo gum, live oaks and water oaks, maples, wax myrtles, willow trees, wild irises, lilly pads, and other water plants from late spring to mid summer.

Traveling east on Hwy. 90, take the exit (185) to Hwy. 20 turn left and head east to Hwy. 182 onto Hwy. 182 at the "Y" go approximately 6 miles to Gibson and turn into Bob's Bayou Black Marina.

Traveling west on Hwy. 90, take the exit (200) head south on Hwy. 311 to Savanne Rd. on Savanne Rd. to Hwy. 182, take a right on Hwy. 182 head west on Hwy. 182 approximately 6 miles, turn into Bob's Bayou Black Marina.

Traveling from Houma, get on St. Charles Blvd. or Barrow St. head west and they both lead to Hwy. 182, turn right on Hwy. 182 head west approximately 15 - miles to Bob's Bayou Black Marina.
