# Beauregard-Keyes House & Garden



- = Beautifully restored nineteenth-century interiors
- = Built by noted architect Francois Correjolle
- = Home to Swiss Consul John A. Merle and wife, Anais, who created the parterre garden in the 1830's
- = Famous Confederate General P. G. T. Beauregard lodged here in 1867
- = Wine merchant Corrado Giacona confronts Sicilian "Black Hand" extortionists on the back gallery in 1908
- = Restored by noted author Frances Parkinson Keyes in 1948
